Dear Parents,

Welcome back

We hope and pray that this newsletter reaches you in strong *imān* and good health.

Alhamdulillah the new academic year will be starting next week on Wednesday 1st September and we are looking forward to welcoming all the children and parents back to school. In the first few weeks we will be focusing on establishing routines and monitoring and assessing the children to determine their starting points.

We have many exciting things planned for this year including the launch of our new vision for Apex Trust.

- New Driveway for the school Alhamdulillah, over the summer we started the works to transform the school drive with the money raised from the last two fundraisers. Unfortunately, the works have already exceeded the projected budget due to relocation of important pipes and cables, and so far the actual spend is £40K. We are hoping there will not be any other unexpected costs and have started a launchgood campaign to see if we can raise money to cover the extra costs. - Over the first few weeks we shall be using the side gates for both entry and exit across the key stages, due to limited access to the front school entrance.
- **COVID guidance -** Although restrictions have been lifted for COVID, we will continue to observe safe practices at least for Autumn term to ensure that isolation periods are kept low for staff and children. From September the new guidance states that children (under 18) and those that are double vaccinated do not have to isolate unless they test positive or are showing symptoms of COVID. This means that if any child or staff member shows symptoms of COVID will be isolated at school and sent home to

have a PCR test. Anyone who has had contact with someone with symptoms or tested positive should also take a PCR test. If the adult is not double vaccinated they will also have to isolate for 10 days, however children under 18 do not need to isolate. At Apex we will continue with the hygiene measures (sanitizing and washing hands), we will continue with the one way system of movement around the school, children will remain in bubbles for playtimes and lunchtimes).

We will be limiting visitors and parents to set meeting times and dealing with queries at the door where possible.

- Welcome letters and learning journeys All teachers will be preparing welcome letters to send out. These will give you an introduction to the teacher and set out information to help parents over the course of the year. Parents will also receive the Autumn learning journeys which will give an overview of the theme and teaching and learning for the term. Please use these to support your child at home.
- **Parent Workshops online** We have scheduled these workshops to further inform and explain to parents about the teaching and learning strategies we use. This is also an opportunity for parents to ask questions.
