MORNING DROP OFF SCHEME

We have introduced a drop off scheme allowing parents to drop off children at the front of the school at 8:00 - 8:10am and no earlier. Staff assists pupils out of the cars and take responsibility for ensuring children enter the school gate through the allocated entrance. Parents enter Argyle Road from Northbrook Road and must exit through Beal Road (see map below). This will ensure traffic to flow safely. Parents arriving earlier than 8:10am should follow the Park and Walk Policy. Cars should not be parked on Argyle Road at any time during drop off.

- **End of term holiday** - School will close for two weeks holiday on Friday 17th December and re-open in the new year on Wednesday 5th January 2022
