#### Walk to school

MashaAllah, we have had a big number of children walking to school as part of our Walk to School Badges Travel Tracker! However, we would love to see more children be active and walk to school on a daily basis.

Remember, if a child walks, scoots or cycles to school for at least 10 minutes a minimum of 3 times per week; they will receive a badge. If they manage to receive 3 out of 4 badges in the month, they will get 10 Dojo points at the end of the month.

#### Tox Free Childcore

You can get up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare. This goes up to £1,000 every 3 months if a child is disabled (up to £4,000 a year).




