EMERGENCY DENTAL PROTOCOL FOR 0-18 YEAR OLDS



A BABY TOOTH IS KNOCKED OUT

- 1. Contact your dentist as soon as possible. QUICK ACTION can lessen a child's discomfort and PREVENT INFECTION.
- 2. Rinse the mouth with water and apply a COLD COMPRESS to reduce swelling
- 3. Spend time COFORTING THE CHILD rather than looking for tooth. Remember baby teeth should not be replanted because of potential damage to developing permanent teeth.



A PERMANANET TOOTH IS KNOCKED OUT

- 1. Find the tooth. Rinse it gently with milk. DO NOT use soap or water.
- 2. REPLACE THE TOOTH in the socket and hold it there with clean gauze or a wash cloth. If you can not put the tooth back in the socket, place the tooth in a clean container, preferably with cold milk. If milk is not available put in a container with the child's saliva, but NOT IN
- 3. Take the child and tooth to your dentist IMMEDIATELY or call the emergency dentist if it is after hours.



A TOOTH IS CHIPPED OR BROKEN

- 1. Contact your dentist IMMEDIATELY. Fast action can save the tooth, prevent infection, and reduce the need for extensive dental
- 2. Rinse the mouth with water, and apply a COLD COMPRESS to reduce swelling.
- 3. If a parent can find the broken tooth fragment, it is important to TAKE IT TO THE DENTIST.



AN ACTIVITY INVOLVES RISK OF FALLS **OR COLLISIONS**

- 1. Wear a MOUTHGUARD when an activity involves a risk of falls, collisions or contact with hard surfaces or equipment
- 2. Pre-Formed Mouthguards can be purchased in sporting goods stores, or CUSTOMISED MOUTH GUARDS can me made at your dentist.



BROKEN ORTHODONTIC WIRE

Use a pencil eraser to try to fold any sharp ends of the wires back down safely, if that doesn't work use orthodontic wax to cover the wire, or gauze. Book an appointment with your orthodontist as soon as possible.



TOOTHACHE

Rinse your mouth thoroughly with warm water, if the toothache is caused by food stuck in your teeth, try using dental floss to dislodge it. Otherwise apply a cold compresses while waiting to see the dentists, in order to alleviate pain and swelling. You may also take calpol or ibruropfen, following any instructions on the medication label, and if you are not allergic to them.
