Drop in sessions

Tax Free Childcare

You can get up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare. This goes up to £1,000 every 3 months if a child is disabled (up to £4,000 a year).

Additionally, if you have any concerns regarding your child, we kindly ask that you speak directly to the school staff rather than discussing the issue with other parents or sharing messages in group chats.


