Asalaamu 'alaikum wa rahmatullahi wa barakatuhu.



Our Reception children enjoy a full day at school whilst Nursery children have the option to attend full or half day sessions.

CURRICULUM KS1 & KS2

THEMATIC CURRICULUM

At Apex we bring learning to life by following a thematic curriculum called Learning Journeys where subjects are taught in a fun and holistic way linked to a theme, making learning a rich and meaningful experience for children. All subjects follow the new National Curriculum except for religious subjects*.

QURAN & ARABIC

Focus is given on reading Arabic fluently with emphasis given on memorising and understanding the surahs in Juz ‘Amma. Children are taught basic tajwid, with accurate pronunciation (makharij) and simple Arabic grammar.





ISLAMIC STUDIES

(Includes aspects of SMSC, PSHE and Citizenship)

We have developed a bespoke curriculum which has been designed specifically with our children and ethos in mind. The broad teachings of Islam are interlinked in "The Journey" which takes our children through the history of the world (from beginning to end; Adam 'alayhi s-salam to Jannah). It covers stories from the noble Qur'an and the authentic Sunnah.

Children learn about the articles of faith, previous prophets, the Sirah and the rich Islamic history. Prayer and other practical aspects of Islam are taught hands-on through projects and discussions (halqas). The spirituality of our children is also supported with religious assemblies, the Muhasabah Booklet and an emphasis on Islamic morals and manners, which are reinforced by our values.

Throughout the year other themed days / weeks are inter-woven into the curriculum to extend the breadth and balance of opportunities we offer our pupils. These include Anti-bullying week; Qur'an week; World book day; Science week; Money week and more.

PERSONALISED LEARNING

Assessment

Pupils progress is monitored throughout the year to ensure pupils are progressing well. Assessment for learning enables us to structure work suited to individual needs and regular assessment helps track pupil progress and review individual targets.

Special Educational Needs (SEN)

We believe that all children have the right to have access to a good education. The school seeks to be sensitive to children with SEN and those who need help in their learning. We operate a carefully planned policy to identify their needs and then ensure they are appropriately met. Each case is assessed individually. Our SEN Policy is available on request.

English as an Additional Language (EAL)

The school also seeks to accommodate children that require additional language support by identifying their needs and how they can be met. Our EAL Policy is available on request.

High Achievers

Our assessment allows us to identify those children who need to be challenged further and measures are put in place to ensure higher progression.

At Apex, taking care of individual pupils' educational needs is our priority.

Educational Visits

At Apex we place great emphasis on enhancing children's learning and bring it to life through a range of wider opportunities. Hence, we organise exciting educational visits every half term! We also invite visitors to the school to share their expertise.

Residential Trips

One of the main highlights of the year is the Year 4, 5 and 6 annual residential trip which includes various recreational activities, which are fun and stimulating; and help to nurture independence and a range of essential life skills.

Extra-Curricular

We offer a range of different clubs such as Cookery, Sports and Hifdh at the school. These run in the mornings and after school. We also offer booster classes to those pupils who we feel require additional support.

Partnerships

The school has established a number of successful partnerships with other organisations such as the Three Faith Forum and Elmhurst Teaching Alliance. We organise an annual food collection for the homeless in winter as an affiliate of FORMO (Federation of Redbridge Muslim Organisations). Our pupils also raise funds which go towards sponsoring an orphan in a third world country.
